## PROMOTERS CONDITIONS:

### THE CITY OF PLYMOUTH LEVEL 3 ANNUAL SWIM MEET

1. The City of Plymouth Annual Swim Meet will be held under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing and licensed at level 3 for inclusion in British Swimming Rankings.
2. The City of Plymouth Annual Swim Meet is limited to the clubs that have paid their affiliation fee to the City of Plymouth S.A. in the year of competition. All affiliation fees must be paid by the 1<sup>st</sup> March prior to the closing date for the entries.  
Affiliated Clubs: **Plymouth Leander, Mount Kelly, Devonport Royal SA, Dinnaton SC, Tavistock SC, Plymouth RN/RM SC, Kingsbridge Kingfishers & Caradon SC.**
3. **Age Groups:** Competitor's age groups shall be defined as at October 12<sup>th</sup> 2025.  
**Open:** 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & 17 & Over including Masters.  
**Female:** 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & 17 & Over including Masters.
4. 9 Year old competitors may NOT enter the 100m Free, 400m Free, 800m Free, 1500m Free, 100 Breast, 100m Back, 100m Fly, 200m Fly or 400IM.  
  
10 Year old competitors may NOT enter the 800m Free, 1500m Free or 400 IM
5. The Female Category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the Female category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
6. **Entries:**  
**2025 Entry Fees:**  
**Individual = £6 per event**  
**Relays = £10.00 for up to 2 teams per club per relay event.**
7. Closing date for all entries (Individual & Relay events) is Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2025. Dates of birth, Swim England numbers and fees **must accompany entries**. Failure to submit payment accordingly, may lead to a club not being permitted to compete. When making payment of entry fees, please forward a screen shot of the payment page to the competition secretary.
8. Entry times should appear on British Swimming Rankings or Masters Database and be the fastest time currently held by a swimmer either Short Course or Long Course. However, if no times are available, club certified times are acceptable but clubs may be asked for proof.
9. The meet promoter will check entry times against the British Rankings where it is felt that a swimmer may be submitting a slower time to gain entry to this meet.
10. Entries without a time will be rejected unless discussed and agreed with the promoter prior to the advertised closing date.
11. If a swimmer's fastest time on British Rankings is no longer an accurate reflection of their current performance level, then the option to enter on the fastest time achieved in the preceeding 24 months can be considered. This must be discussed and agreed with the promoter prior to the advertised closing date.

12. If a swimmer is found to have entered a false entry time they will be disqualified from the event and their time will not be uploaded to rankings. If the false time is identified following the meet, the entry will be reported to British Rankings with a request for the time to be deleted.
13. Entries without a correct Swim England registration number will be rejected. All swimmers are to be registered as Club Compete members, on entry closing date.
14. All entries must be made electronically (unless agreed beforehand) & by the closing date. Club officers will be given the opportunity to check entries & correct any errors.  
There will be no changes to times after this & no changes will be permitted on the day!
15. No refunds will be given for withdrawals after acceptance of entries unless the withdrawal is for medical reasons and accompanied by a Doctor's note.
16. **NO** Deck entries or late entries for individual or relay events will be accepted.
17. By submitting entries on the official entry file, clubs and competitors accept the rules of this competition.
18. **Disability Swimmers**

**All Disability Swimmers** are eligible to compete in this meet & will be seeded according to achieved time standards and with able bodied or disability swimmers of appropriate times.

Disability Swimmers must have an authorised SE/IPC swimming classification, Certificate of Disability of Function Ability Card. In addition, details of disability must be provided with entry. Please ensure you present Certificate of Disability of Function Ability Card to the Referee prior to each competition session, failure to do so may result in disqualification.

Secondary strobes are available within the starting platforms. An additional strobe may be available on request.

NT's may be accepted at the discretion of the meet organiser, however a coach's time is preferred.

Awards will be issued as per condition 23.

19. This gala is a 'Development Gala' & if the meet were to be oversubscribed & exceeds the time allowed per session the promoters reserve the right to limit entries to enable the gala to meet licensing requirements. Any scratches will come from the fastest swimmers entered and equally scratched across all age groups and events.
20. The Meet Promoter will make every effort to run the event. In any situation that the meet must be cancelled, competitors are not eligible for full refunds of their entry fees. Proportionate refunds may be made but only after the promoter has covered all incurred costs.
21. All events will be HDW (except 100m events).
22. **Backstroke Ledges will not be available for use during this Development meet.**

23. There will be a Championship final in all 100m events in both the Open & Female categories. The finalists will be the fastest 8 swimmers, regardless of age. Two reserves will be named for each final. Any swimmer withdrawing from a final must do so within twenty (20) minutes of the announcement to enable the notification of reserve finalists who are required to swim. Once an entry is withdrawn the Final place will be assigned to the next reserve, the original swimmer may not re-enter the Final. Failure to withdraw a swimmer from the Championship final, & who subsequently does not swim will result in a £25 fine to the club of the swimmer.

## 24. Medals & Trophies:

Medals will be awarded to swimmers placing 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each individual event as per the age groups detailed in condition 3.

Medals will also be awarded in each individual event for swimmers placed 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> in the 13 years & under age groups.

Disability swimmers will be awarded medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each individual event as per the age groups detailed in condition 3.

Unless disqualified, all Championship Finalists will receive a keepsake trophy. The Champion will be presented with a Perpetual Challenge Shield to engrave at their expense, hold for one year and return for the next years Championships.

Relay teams placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> will receive medals. The winners of each relay event will also be presented with a Trophy for photographic purposes only.

Times achieved in Relay events will NOT be sent to Rankings.

**All Relay trophies will be retained by the City of Plymouth SA and engraved with the winning team's name at City of Plymouth SA expense.**

25. Perpetual Shields will be issued or not, at the discretion of the Hon. Trophy Steward and upon satisfactory completion of a receipt. The Shields remain the property of the City of Plymouth SA and must not be removed from the County of Devon. Swimmers under 18 years of age will need an adult to sign the receipt on their behalf. In the event of a Shield being unavailable for presentation at the required time, unengraved or in a state unsuitable for presentation, City of Plymouth SA reserve the right to levy a fine of £50 against the club of which the swimmer was a member at the time of the award. Any expenses incurred by City of Plymouth SA for retrieval, replacement, repair or engraving of shields will also be recoverable from the club.

26. Any club not willing to stand surety for the issue of Perpetual Shields, must inform the Hon. Trophy Steward in advance of the meet, by email or by signing a waiver to that effect on the day. Any appeal against the implementation of the above protocols may be submitted in writing to the Hon. Gen. Secretary for discussion at the next scheduled Committee meeting. The decision of the committee shall be final and communicated to the appellant within a reasonable time after the committee has ruled.

27. **Health Restrictions:** Any Health Restrictions in place at the time of the meet imposed either by the UK Government / Plymouth Active and or Swim England must be followed and failure to do so will result in the removal of said individual / club from the meet.

28. **Officials & Poolside Helpers:** All City of Plymouth SA Clubs are requested to provide a **minimum** of 1 Qualified Official per session, and an additional official for every 10 swimmers entered in each session.

In the unfortunate event that a club cannot provide qualified officials they are requested to liaise with the promoter and/or volunteer coordinator to provide additional volunteer helpers in addition to those already required. All volunteers must be Swim England registered.

**To meet licensing requirements, we strongly encourage as many Qualified and Trainee officials as possible to help with the running of this event.**

29. **Coaches & Team Managers:** All Teams must be accompanied by at least one Level 2 or Swim England Swimming Coach who must have current Safeguarding and DBS passes. Team Managers on poolside must be TM1 Qualified and be DBS Checked. It is the responsibility of the Clubs to check all poolside volunteers have up-to-date DBS and safeguarding certificates.
30. All clubs are responsible in ensuring that sufficient space is given on the pool deck to allow officials to perform their duties safely. Coaches and Team Managers are responsible for ensuring that sufficient space is available and that all swimmers & club personnel are stood behind the Lifeguard chairs on both sides of the pool.
31. The City of Plymouth Swimming Association uses a computer to manage entries and results. By submitting and accepting entries to the meet consent is hereby given, as required by GDPR - Data Protection Act 2018, to the holding of personal information on computer. Personal data such as name, club, entered/achieved times may be made public prior to, during or after the meet (e.g., programs, results, etc).
32. The pool is 25m x 10 lanes and the competition will be swum short course. Anti-turbulence lane ropes will be in place and electronic timing/placing will be used wherever possible. There will be a secondary strobe available on the starting system for all races.
33. 2 swim lanes will be available for warm down in the adjacent pool.
34. On acceptance of entries, the swimmer and any supporters agree that their behaviour will be of an appropriate and respectful manner abiding by the Rules of the competition and venue. Failure to do so could result in removal or refusal of entry.
35. The promoter or Plymouth Active do not accept responsibility for any property. Lockers must be used for all swim bags. Only small food bags will be permitted on poolside, together with swimmers' poolside footwear, club shirt, towel, and water bottles. Items have gone missing in the past so please look after your belongings.
36. If participating Competitors or other Club members on poolside suffer injury or damage as a result of any failure by any person to follow the regulations set out then neither the Promoter nor Plymouth Active will accept any liability in respect of any such injury or damage.
37. All participating competitors are deemed to be aware of these conditions and it is each participating Clubs responsibility to make their members aware of these conditions.

## 38. **Photography & Video Recording:**

In Line with Swim England & Wavepower guidance, anyone wishing to take images (Photo or video) are requested to focus on their own children as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends or through social media platforms.

**The use of mobile phones and video or photo capturing devices in the changing room areas are strictly prohibited during this meet.**

For the full Swim England guidance on the use of recording or streaming devices during the duration of the competition parents should consult the Swim England Wavepower Policy:

**You are reminded that flash photography is not permitted at the start of any heat.**

39. Changing on poolside is forbidden and the changing village must be used. Team Managers and Coaches are expected to enforce this rule. Any swimmer found changing on poolside or in any area other than the changing village may be disqualified from further events and the club reported to Swim England.

40. **Swimmers WILL be required to sign in for all 200m events + 400m IM, 400m free, 800m free & 1500m freestyle events. Clubs of any swimmer who signed in and then subsequently does NOT swim will be fined £10 per swimmer.** Sign in must be completed by commencement of each session warmup in which the event is swam. Failure to sign in before warmup has commenced will result in the swimmer being removed from the event.

41. Competitors must report to the stewards at the marshalling area at least 3 events prior to their event where they will be given their starting order. It is the responsibility of coaches and swimmers to ensure that swimmers report to the marshalling area in good time. Any swimmer not reporting may be deemed to have withdrawn from that event.

42. **The Leaze Shield** is awarded every year in recognition of endeavour and excellence. Nominations are invited from the clubs within the City of Plymouth group for deserving candidates. The Chairman will then decide who receives the award which will be presented at the Lord Mayors parlour along with our other prize winners. Please email the Chairman directly detailing why you are nominating that person/group. Anyone can nominate although the nominee must have participated in the City of Plymouth Championships for that year and be a member of an affiliated club.

## 43. **Relay Events:**

- b) Mixed (maximum of 2 Male/Open swimmers): 4 x 50 metre Freestyle & Medley Relay for 13/U
- c) Mixed (maximum of 2 Male/Open swimmers): 4 x 50 metre Freestyle & Medley Relay for 14/O
- d) Mixed (maximum of 3 Male/Open swimmers) 6 x 50 metre Freestyle Relay – 2 swimmers aged 13 & Under, 2 swimmers aged 14 & Over and 2 other swimmers.
- e) All swimmers must be eligible for individual events and have entered at least one individual event, at the 2025 City of Plymouth Annual Swim Meet.
- f) Closing date for entries to be as for the City of Plymouth Swim Meet Competition.
- g) Names of Relay swimmers **MUST** be submitted to the promoter by the end of the session prior to that Relay.
- h) Times achieved will **NOT** be sent to Rankings.
