Firstly, apologies for not getting this out earlier but we wanted to ensure that we had enough officials. I am pleased to say that we are now able to run 10 lanes in all sessions. Please could you thank all officials and volunteers for signing up to help.

We very much look forward to meeting you all for the first weekend of The 2025 City of Plymouth Annual Swim Meet being held at the Life Centre this weekend (4th & 5th Oct).

I have attached separate copies of the meet program for each session and copies of the warm up schedule for each day.

Programs will not be on sale for this gala so please make these available to your parents and swimmers.

However, Please Note:

The heat sheets currently provided will be as a guide only as this weekend we will have sign ins for the 200m backstroke events, 400m IM & 800m freestyle events. Relay lanes are also a guide only until names are submitted.

Sign in sheets will be located on the table outside the control room. These events **MAY** then be reseeded if there are any withdrawals, so please do not expect your swimmers to stay in those lanes/heats.

Sign in must be completed by commencement of each session warmup in which the event is swam. Failure to sign in before warmup has commenced will result in the swimmer being removed from the event.

SWIMMERS MUST SIGN IN FOR THE 400IM & 200 BACKSTROKE BEFORE SESSION 2 WARM-UP BEGINS

SWIMMERS MUST SIGN IN FOR THE 800m FREESTYLE BEFORE SESSION 4 WARM-UP BEGINS

Clubs are to use the areas detailed on the attached seating plan for their swimmers & coaches:

Balcony above diving area - Plymouth Leander
(Swimmers will be asked to sit in the spectator area next to MK until approx 13:30 on Saturday & Sunday)

Balcony above control Room - Mount Kelly

Please could all teams advise parents/spectators that this area is strictly for swimmers and club support staff only. This includes the desks directly above the seating area which are to be shared equally between Plymouth Leander & Mount Kelly.

Poolside - RNRM, Tavistock, DRSA, Caradon, Dinnaton & Kingsbridge.

The Medal table will be situated on the balcony with 100m championship and Relay awards being presented on poolside. Please ensure that all swimmers for these awards are wearing club shirts at the presentation.

For this weekend only, Swimpath are providing a swim shop selling performance & competition swim wear. The shop will be situated at the flume end of the pool balcony .

Footwear **MUST** be worn whilst transiting between the balcony and the pool.

Pisces Swimming club are using the Diving Pool on Sunday & access to pool side and the control room via the diving pool entrance is strictly prohibited until 1:15pm. Please access the pool area using the central entrance through the changing village.

Could Coaches and Team Managers please sign in at the desk outside the Control Room when they arrive. They will be given a pass which should be worn for the duration of the meet.

All unauthorised individuals on poolside will be asked to leave.

Many thanks to those volunteers who will be helping poolside over the weekend. Could you please sign in at the control desk on arrival before the session warm-up so we know that all helpers have arrived. Warm-up marshals will need to be present 10 minutes before warm-up.

All Clubs are fully responsible for their swimmers whilst in the 2 lanes allocated for swim down so please could you ensure that you adequately resource this.

Please could you remind all swimmers and coaches that the Life Centre will remove any bags on blocking the ventilation system on poolside. Please, wherever possible, use the lockers provided by the Life Centre to store belongings.

Plymouth Argyle are playing at home on Saturday 4th @ 3pm. Parking will be extremely difficult in and around Plymouth Life Centre.
